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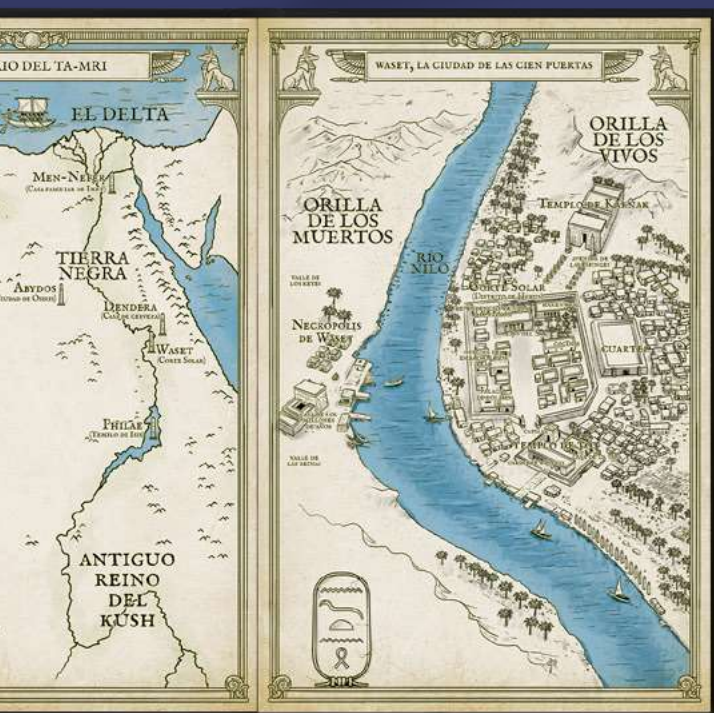

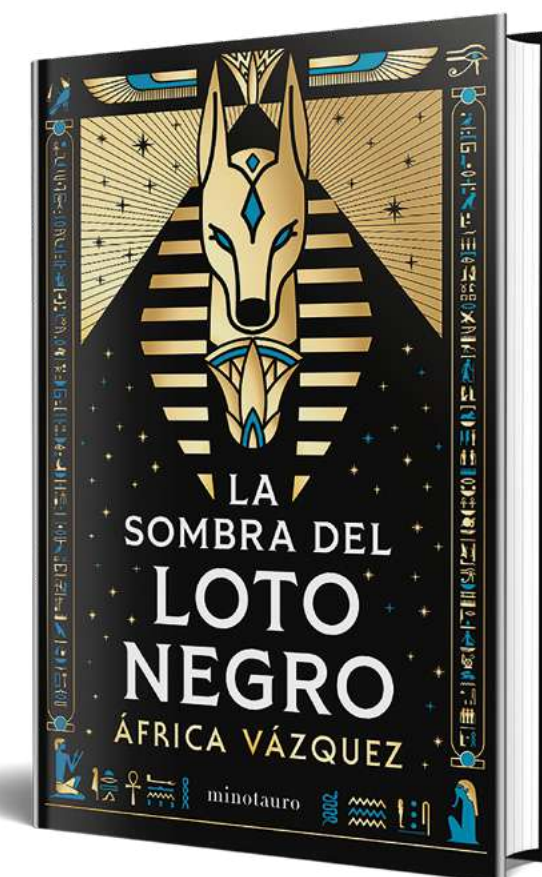

Imet was raised to obey. At sixteen, a novice in the temple of Isis, she serves in silence while her gifted sister prepares for the priesthood—until the Nile yields the body of a young woman poisoned with black lotus, a forbidden substance tied to the gods. Convinced her sister is in danger, Imet interrupts a sacred rite and is publicly disgraced, stripped of her rank, and cast out. She survives only because the royal embalmer takes her in as an apprentice, initiating her into the perilous knowledge of death.

Ten years later, hardened by exile and loss, that knowledge becomes a weapon. Summoned to the palace, the embalmers—including Imet's mentor—are slaughtered. The Nile begins to disgorge the walking dead. The court descends into paranoia. When the Pharaoh falls in battle only to rise again before the court, the truth is undeniable: he has stolen immortality from the gods through a corrupted ritual—one paid for with the embalmers' blood.

Driven by vengeance, Imet infiltrates the empire from its lowest kitchens to its most guarded sanctums, adopting shifting identities—servant, healer, traitor—while forging a dangerous alliance with Akil, the Pharaoh's disgraced commander.

As the kingdom edges toward collapse, Imet must descend into the Underworld itself to destroy the source of the Pharaoh's power—knowing that that defying gods and kings alike may cost her the fragile future she has only just begun to imagine.

In Elenda, violent and traumatic deaths can give birth to the Invited — grotesque creatures that haunt the land and feed its darkest superstitions. Entire rural communities live under the constant threat of monstrous transformation.

Kendarian Molino was once a respected investigator. Now he is a disgraced civil servant, quietly exiled to Raven Valley to look into the disappearance of three young women. The case carries little political weight, just enough to require an official report. No one expects answers. Least of all the people who live there.

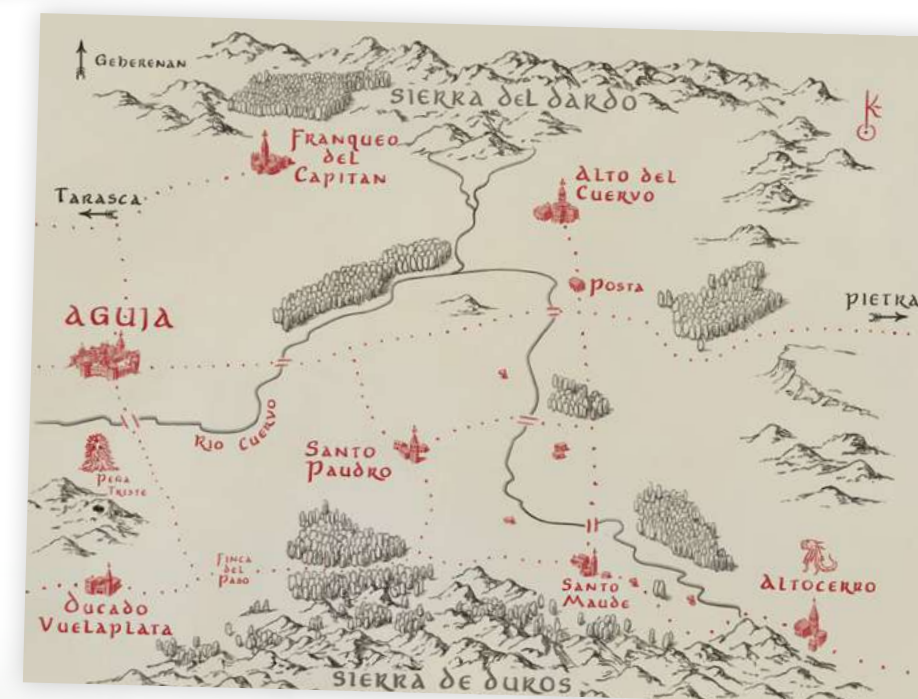

Salazar, a human necromancer known as the Carrion-Eater, has helped the dryad king Mirtalon win a devastating war. His reward is not gold, but a daughter of the court—one chosen to travel with him and restore his barren lands. His choice is met with disbelief when he claims Talía, the feared bastard known as Deathflower: daughter of the fae king and a human witch.

Raised among the fae after her mother's sacrifice, Talía has always existed out of place. While other dryads draw power from the living song of nature, her magic blooms only from corpses—beautiful, lethal, and deeply unsettling. In Everwood, even her two older sisters shun her, and she finds companionship and protection only in Jara, her youngest sister.

Beyond the living lands of the fae lie the Ashlands, Salazar's domain: a world of bone and silence, where the Earth no longer sings and nothing should grow. There, far from courtly intrigue, Salazar teaches Talía to face the power she fears most. From death itself, she makes a garden bloom—dark, violent, breathtaking. In those lifeless lands, Talía begins to flourish, and Salazar—who understands solitude and loss—finds himself irrevocably drawn to her.

But when the time of the pact ends, Talía must return to Everwood, only to discover that home offers her no refuge. Her growing power turns her into a threat, a weapon, a prize to be claimed. As factions close in and her father retreats behind silence and authority, Talía is forced to confront a final truth: the living world has no place for her—though the dead one might.

Marshel Allen wants only one thing: to study under the controversial Doctor Viktor Frank. When the prestigious Golstadt School of Alchemy offers scholarships to talented students of limited means, she seizes her chance. Curious and unusually gifted, Marshel soon catches Viktor's attention, and he draws her into a world where science borders on heresy and nature can be rewritten through symbols, sacrifice, and blood.

But Marshel has not come to Golstadt simply to learn. Violent attacks of pain torment her, and she needs access to Viktor's knowledge to find a cure. Three years earlier, Viktor led the Demiurge Experiment, an attempt to create life from the remains of the dead. Seven creatures awoke that night. The alchemists who assembled them were slaughtered, and the creations vanished. Since then, Viktor has devoted himself to hunting them down and erasing the mistake that bears his name.

For Marshel, being discovered would mean death: she is the seventh creature. Unlike the others, she does not seek revenge but a life of her own—one in which pain does not consume her. And to obtain it, she will risk everything. Yet the closer Marshel draws to her creator, the harder it becomes to reconcile the ruthless alchemist hunting her kind with the grief-stricken man beneath. Against her better judgment, fascination deepens into forbidden desire.

With the surviving creatures closing in and the Council of Alchemy investigating Viktor's crimes, it is only a matter of time before Marshel's secret comes to light. When the truth emerges, they must decide whether humanity is determined by how someone is born—or by what they choose to become.

Viktor Frank is hunting the monsters he created, unaware that his brilliant new pupil is one of them.

Ethel Ashbourne has always felt like an accident waiting to happen—afraid of what she might do, unsure she can trust her own mind. After a serious incident at school, she's sent to live with her grandmother and aunts in Ebonwick, a remote town where time seems to have stalled.

There, Ethel uncovers the secret her family has been keeping from her: the Ashbournes are witches, and their bloodline is bound to an ancient pact with a Prince of the Underworld. The more an Ashbourne woman uses that inherited power, the closer she gets to becoming a "blood witch"—a creature the Prince can claim—a succubus. Ethel's mother tried to starve the magic out of her, to raise her "more human than witch"—but Ethel was born with magic too strong to contain, and terrifying things occurred around her.

Then Nox Harker arrives. Charismatic and unsettlingly attentive, he seems to orbit Ethel with predatory patience. Behind the façade, Nox is exactly what she fears: a demon caught between obedience and desire, sent to awaken her blood magic and drive her toward the inevitable.

As Ethel's awakening accelerates, the town's veneer cracks: bodies appear, faith turns feral, and an enemy inside Ebonwick begins hunting the Ashbournes with rituals steeped in black magic. The deeper Ethel digs into her family's past—and the Underworld's rules—the more she realizes the true horror isn't that she might become a monster, but that everyone around her has been managing that outcome for years.

The Ashbournes hide a dangerous secret: they are witches, and a centuries-old curse binds them all.

Pixy has spent her life trying to belong in the Realm of Dreams. One of the most powerful dream-projectors of her generation, she guards the portals that keep nightmares from crossing into the human world. Yet in a society where purity is measured by white hair, her black hair marks her as cursed — a hybrid. Abandoned, battling addiction and chronic pain, and trapped in a toxic love, she is certain she won't live long. When her only friend, Axia, is taken beyond the portals dividing Humans, Dreams, and Nightmares, Pixy follows.

In the Realm of Nightmares, the king is dead and his three sons — Terrence, Nocte, and Somna — compete for the throne. The prince whose champion survives three deadly trials will inherit the crown. Pixy is forced to fight for Terrence, while Axia becomes Nocte's. As the trials unfold, alliances shift and Pixy's friendship with Axia fractures under envy, loyalty, and ambition.

What no one anticipates is that he will fall for Pixy — the one woman whose death would secure his reign.

In the kingdom she was taught to fear, Pixy confronts the truth: dreams and nightmares are not opposites, but mirrors — and only by facing both can she reclaim her power.

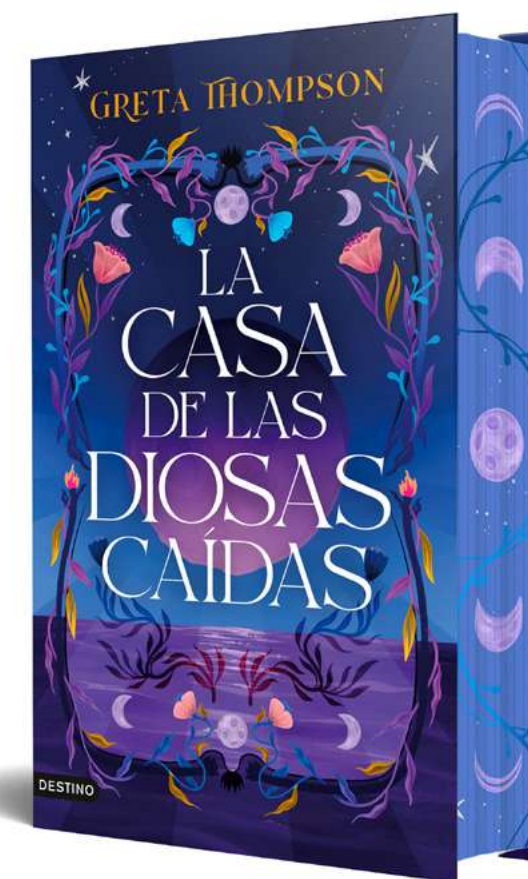

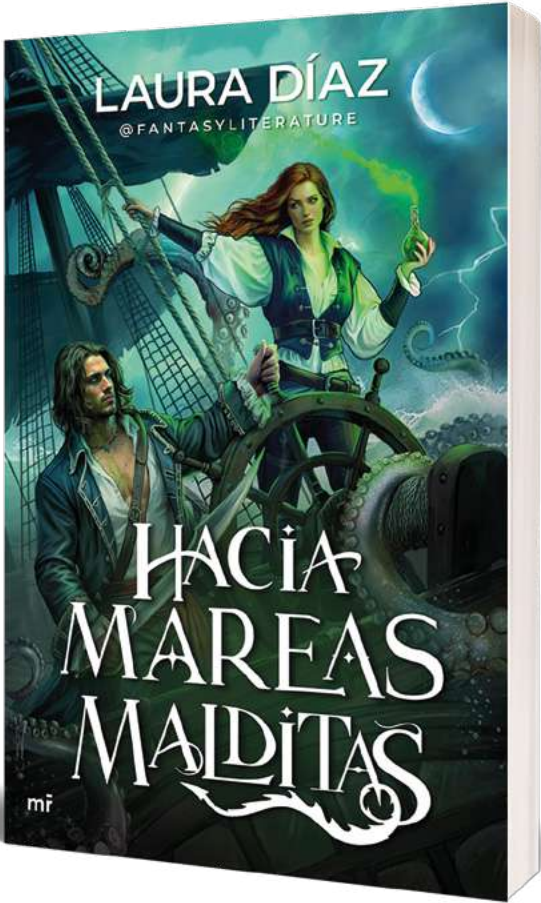
