Who gets to decide the state of a woman's mind? And what happens when that judgment becomes her story?

Through the lives of ten women from different periods, backgrounds and geographies, *Out of My Mind* explores how social context, patriarchal oppression, violence and fame have shaped the way women are seen, judged, and remembered.

This is not a clinical treatise, a novel, or an academic essay. It is a literary and visual inquiry into the moment when a life becomes a diagnosis, a rumour, a myth or a warning. Natalie Wood, Sinéad O'Connor, Yayoi Kusama, Virginia Woolf, Agustina González, Carlota of Mexico, Mary Todd Lincoln, Simone Weil, Cheslie Kryst, Conce... Ten names, though there could have been many more.

With Violeta Gil's intimate, politically alert prose and Ana Jarén's colourful, delicate, and deeply contemporary illustrations, the book restores complexity to women too often reduced to spectacle, scandal, or symptom. What first appears as "madness" reveals itself as a much more unsettling web of pain, resistance, creativity, loneliness, power and control.

From a 21st-century perspective, and through the deeply human gaze of literature and art, *Out of My Mind* invites us to look again: at these women, at the stories told about them, and at the time in which we live.



ARTIST



ANA JARÉN is an illustrator and visual artist. She began her career in fashion communication, where she developed an aesthetic gaze focused on the everyday and femininity, which she later brought into her own artistic work. Her colourful, delicate and contemporary style places women at the centre of intimate scenes, exploring identity, bonds and daily life through a dreamlike emotional lens. She works as an illustrator for publishers, media, brands and institutions in Spain and internationally.



AUTHOR



VIOLETA GIL is a writer, philologist, and translator. She is co-founder of the theatre company La tristura, with which she has developed an international career as a writer, director and performer. In 2019, she published her first poetry collection, *Antes de que tiréis mis cosas*, and in 2022 her first novel, *Llego con tres heridas*, a critically acclaimed work of autofiction. Her writing combines intimacy and politics, turning the personal into a way of exploring collective conflicts such as memory, violence and mental health.

Each stop along the journey—from Italy to Japan, from Mexico to Australia, from Egypt to the Congo—pairs carefully selected verses with Alicia Aradilla's distinctive artistic vision. Her oil paintings reinterpret landscapes through colour, gesture and atmosphere, surprising the viewer with the vast diversity of our planet.

The book brings together classical and traditional poetry alongside modern voices, reflecting how different cultures perceive landscape, emotion, and daily life. Across time and geography, brushstrokes and poetic voices merge to create a singular portrait of each place—not merely as territory, but as lived experience.

At a time when travel risks becoming just another form of consumption, these pages remind us of the value of being fully present: of slowing down, looking more closely and allowing ourselves to be moved by beauty.

Through richly coloured oil paintings, Alicia Aradilla creates a luminous dialogue between poetry and place, transforming each landscape into an emotional experience.

ALICIA ARADILLA is an artist and illustrator known for her evocative landscapes and travel sketches. Trained in Fine Arts and Graphic Design, she worked for several years as a graphic designer and art director before dedicating herself fully to painting and illustration. 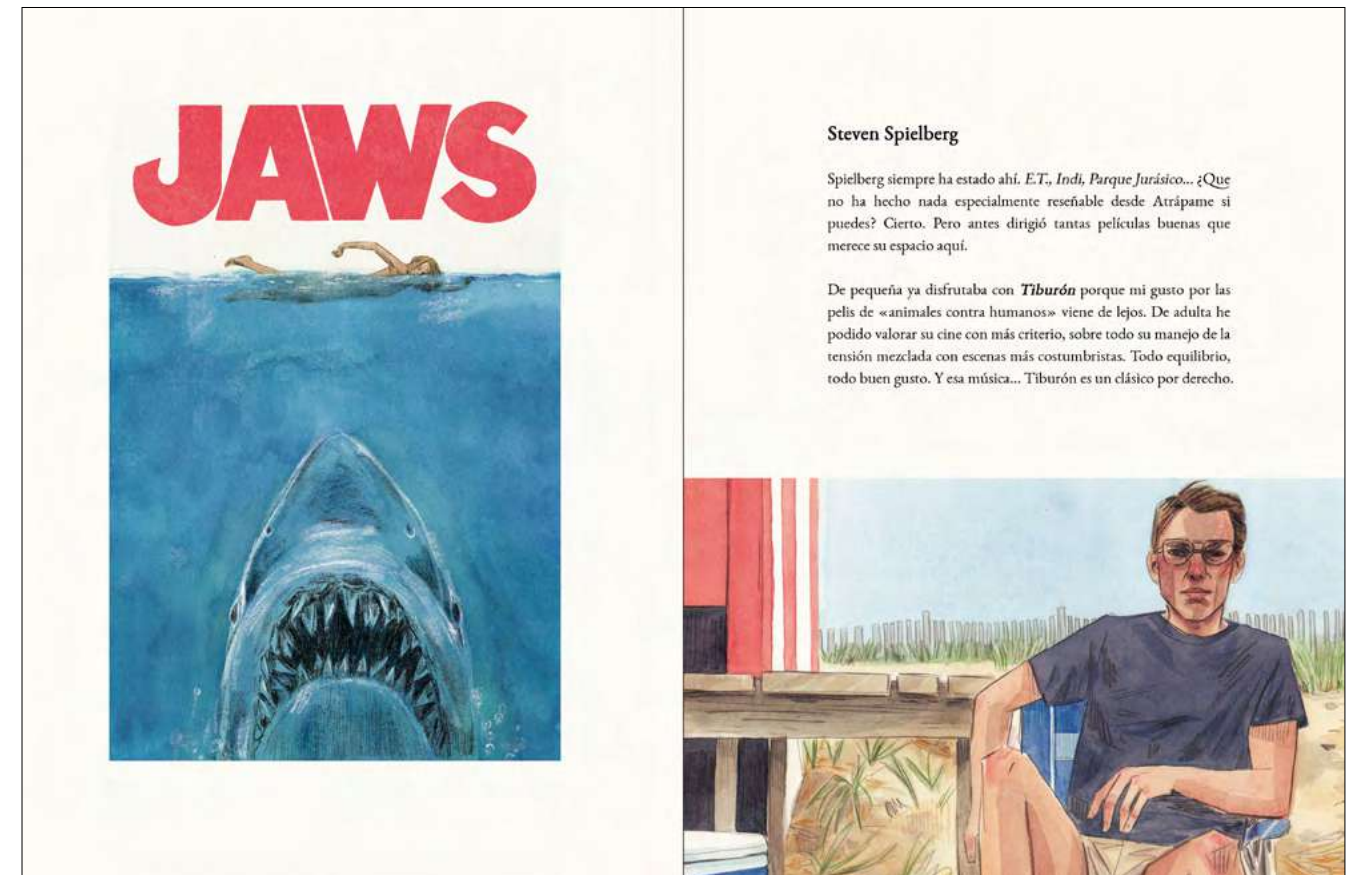

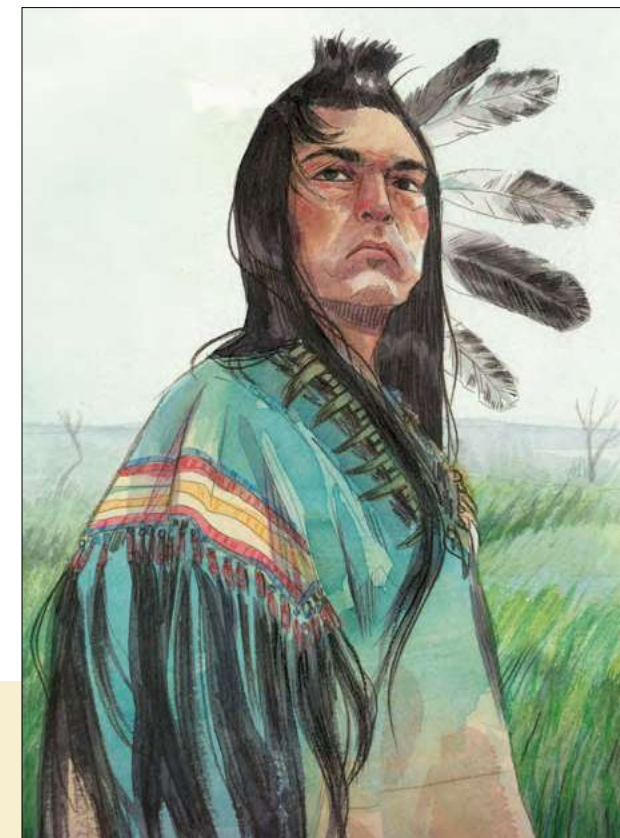

Told in the unsettling voice of Fear itself, this book deals with the monsters we thought we'd outgrown... and the ones that never really left. It's clever, creepy, and strangely comforting, because once you recognise your fear, you can learn to look it in the eye. Even if it has three.

Hello, I'm Fear. I've been here since you discovered there's nothing under the bed... and still don't dare let your arm hang over the edge. I'm the one who makes you look twice down an empty hallway, who whispers that sound wasn't just the house settling.

NURIA DÍAZ is an illustrator with a degree in Fine Arts and a background in graphic design. Her work blends traditional and digital techniques to create poetic, emotionally resonant images with a hint of playful innocence. She has collaborated with leading publishers such as Planeta, Anaya, and Penguin Random House, and is the author and illustrator of titles like *The Grand Hotel* Wes Anderson and *Alfred Hitchcock: The Boy Who Filmed Fear*. ¿De dónde vienen las leyendas?

Las leyendas hablan de los miedos de la sociedad. Son relatos populares que se han transmitido por tradición oral y en los que entremezclan los elementos reales con los imaginarios. Las leyendas tienen su propia función dentro de cada comunidad en las que aparecen, algunas tienen un propósito moral, a otras les interesa transmitir ciertos valores o incluso pueden funcionar como advertencias para prevenir ciertos peligros.

Algunas leyendas universales

El holandés errante

Es un barco fantasma que está condenado a navegar eternamente. Oa recuerda que hay cosas que no puedes controlar ni dominar. La tripulación se encuentra a bordo, pero no muere; las velas están rotas, pero avanza entre las tempestades; y aunque es incapaz de llegar a ningún puerto, en su derrotero va aterrizando en malineros, y quienes lo ven siguen su mismo destino. Esperemos que por lo menos disfruten de las vistas.

El monstruo del lago Ness

¿Un monstruo prehistórico escondido bajo las aguas? Algunos afirman haberlo visto, otros viven con la eterna duda, y otros incluso se han adentrado bajo las aguas para buscar a la criatura—con pésimos resultados—. Lo que sí es cierto es que el negocio turístico de la zona va estupendamente. Quizás no asusta el monstruo en sí, sino la idea de que pueda existir esa criatura desconocida y no se dé con ella.

La Santa Compaña

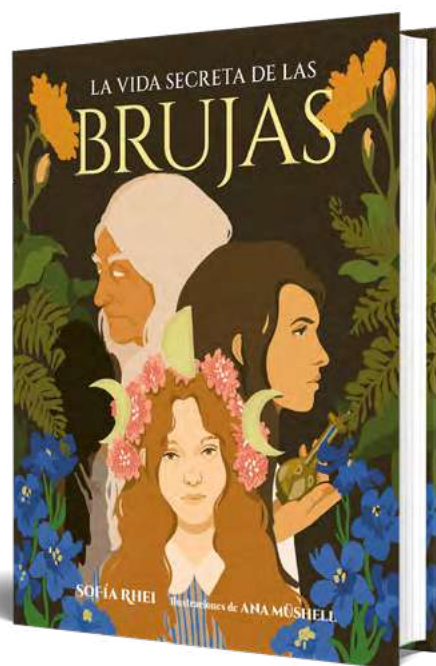
Es una leyenda muy arraigada en Galicia, donde son habituales las historias sobre la procesión de almas en pena que presagian una muerte inminente a quienes ven a la fila de espectros. Caminan en silencio ocultos bajo unas capuchas y llevan una gran cruz y velas encendidas. Para protegerse de la Santa Compaña: dibujar un círculo en el suelo y meterse dentro; refugiarse al lado de un cruceiro, que protegen a los vivos o cerrar los ojos, huir y rezar.

La llorona

La historia de la madre que ahogó a sus hijos y que luego, arrepentida, va vagando por los ríos en su búsqueda es de origen latinoamericano y tiene múltiples versiones.

POITERGEIST

Por sí fuera poco, lo que empieza como un pequeño incidente se transforma en episodios cada vez más intensos. Así, también pueden provocar que los objetos vuelen por el aire, las camas tiemblen, las personas leviten o incluso prender fuego a la ropa y a los muebles.

La buena noticia es que su actividad es inofensiva, pues la intención última de los *poitergeists* no es el daño físico, y su duración tiene un límite, como mucho se repite unos días o unas pocas semanas. Transcurrido este tiempo, la perturbación fantasmal se desvanece sin previo aviso, tal y como surgió. Además, pese a que los *poitergeists* han sido extensamente estudiados en el ámbito de la parapsicología y numerosos informes aseguran demostrar su recurrencia, la posibilidad de presenciar un suceso de esta índole es bastante improbable.

Existen diversas teorías sobre la mecánica de esta escandalosa categoría de apariciones fantasmales. La más aceptada es que los fantasmas extraen su poder de la energía psíquica que emiten ciertas personas de forma involuntaria. Su imposibilidad para perdonar les crea tal sed de venganza que regresan directos al mundo de los vivos. Demostrar su dominio sobre nuestro espacio es su manera de expresar lo terriblemente enfadados que están.

Niños y adolescentes, los más clarividentes

Ese «amigo imaginario» de la infancia puede ser, en realidad, un fantasma. Las apariciones aumentan con la llegada de la pubertad, por la gran cantidad de energía que se emite durante esta etapa.



Las embarazadas tienen un sexto sentido

El bebé que crece en el vientre de la madre transita entre dos mundos, por lo que es probable que tenga guardianes espirituales cerca. Asimismo, durante el embarazo, los sentidos de la mujer se intensifican y se desarrollan facultades para percibir actividad paranormal.



Los gatos pueden ver fantasmas

Aunque todos los animales son capaces de ver y oír a los espíritus —su capacidad sensorial es mucho más aguda que la nuestra—, estos felinos son los que con mayor frecuencia detectan fenómenos ocultos.

Les encanta el olor a limón

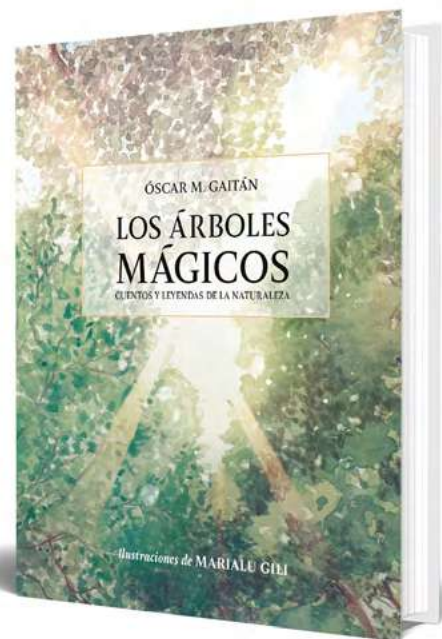

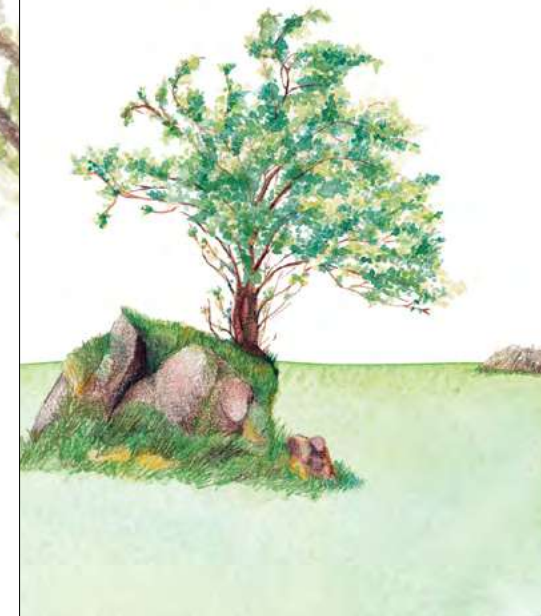

El árbol de los deseos de la cima de las doncellas

—¿Entró alguien en su compartimento después?

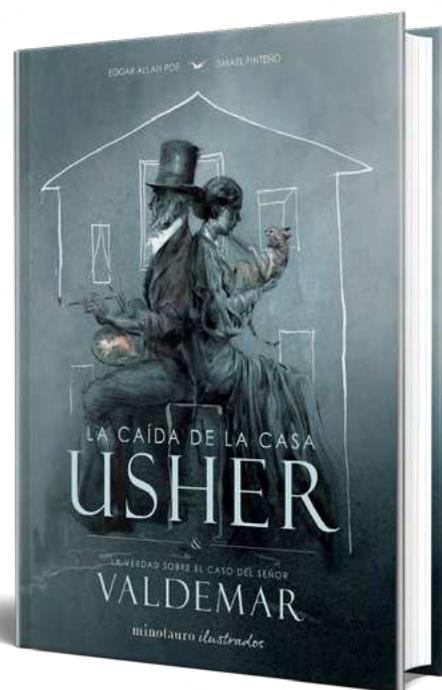

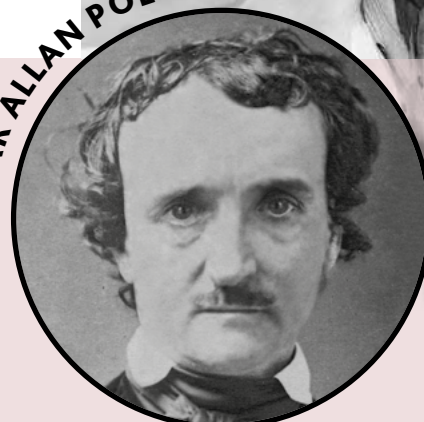

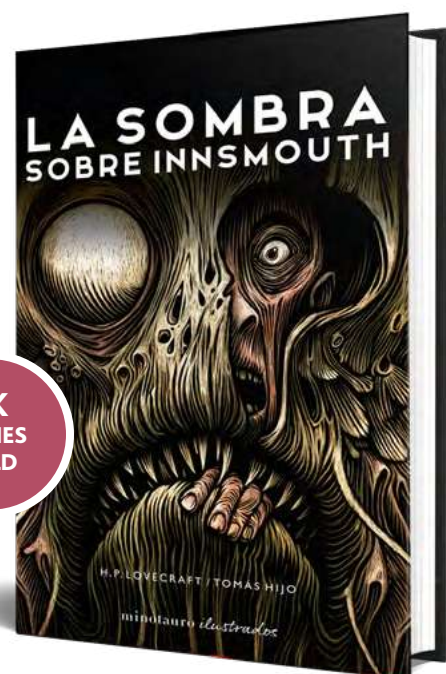
