Vero has always been the perfect student: bright, responsible and determined never to let anyone down. Yet the pressure of constantly meeting expectations has begun to take its toll.

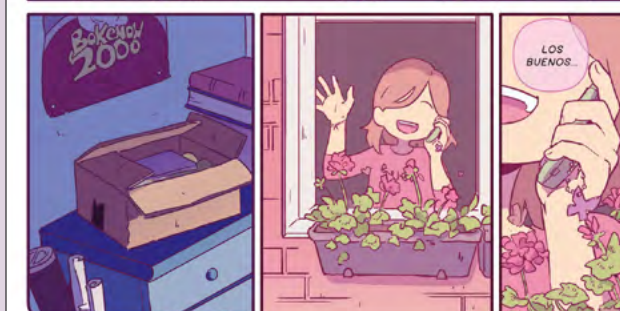
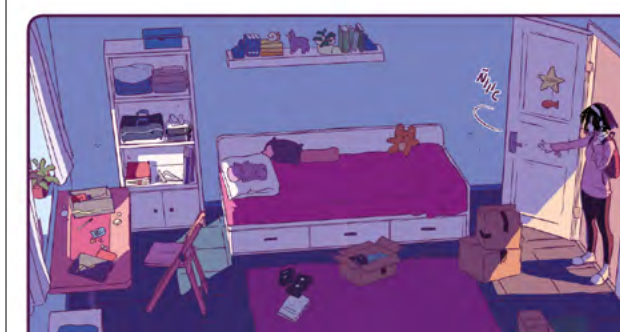

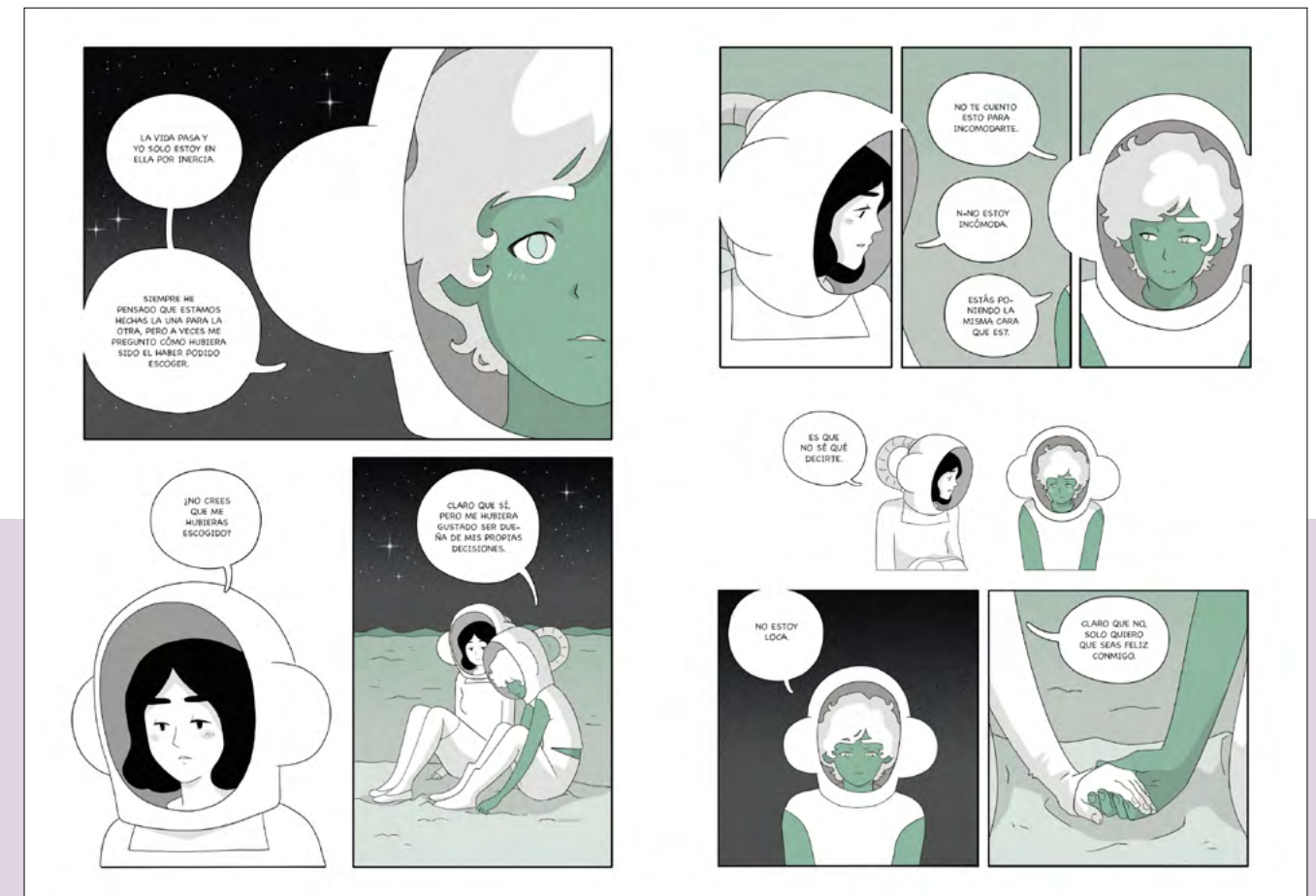

Inma R.'s pastel palette beautifully captures the tenderness of the characters, while the story explores the intricate nuances of love and relationships.

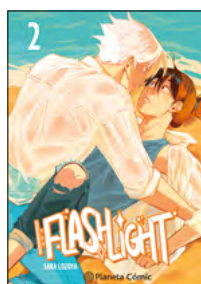
